1. Clarify Payment Methods

- Check: Online Check Automatic Debit Cash
- Add notes for reminders or instructions.
- Make a copy for each sibling so everyone has a clear record. Update as expenses change.

2. Conversation Starters

- Are there bills that can be combined or simplified?
- Who should be notified if a payment is missed?
- Are there expenses that could be reduced or reassigned among siblings?

Pro Tip: Even rough estimates give everyone a realistic picture and prevent surprises later. Keep the worksheet handy and update it regularly, money clarity is a gift to the whole family.
